Dear Parents.

Summer is almost here! We are excited to start our next Summer Camp with many activities and places to see! To our returning families, welcome back! Please read the following carefully as some updates may have been added. To our new families, we're excited for you to be joining us this year! Let us know if you have further questions after reading.

Always check our classroom bulletin board located outside the classroom door and Procare for updates on field trip locations, return times and reminders!

Some things to know:

- Keep all toys and electronics home.
 - o Teachers will notify families if there is a special bring a toy from home day
 - If your child has a smart watch, there will be reminders that it needs to function as a watch (not camera, messenger, toy etc). If these become a disturbance or safety concern we'll ask they be kept home
- Please respect our departure times. Failure to be at Tree Hill on time may result in your child staying at the school and missing out on that day's field trip
- Sunscreen your child *before* coming to Tree Hill. We will re-sunscreen around lunch time.
- Individualized water bottles, snacks, and lunches are provided for your child. Water bottles
 are kept at school and sanitized daily. If you would like to pack your child a lunch please
 make sure they follow Tree Hill's nutritional guidelines and are 100% nut free.
- If a child is not following our safety rules they may be asked to stay back from the next field trip they are in attendance for. If more than one incident occurs there may be a discussion of them being disqualified from any future field trips and kept at Tree Hill or dismissed from our Summer Camp program. We take the safety of each child and the group very seriously.
- We strongly recommend your child come with little to no personal belongings (ex watches, sunglasses, jewelry etc). Tree Hill is not responsible for lost, damaged or misplaced items.
 Every transition the teachers will remind the group to get any personal items. A small sling bag is best to carry items that may be brought (jacket, hat, etc).
- No open-toed shoes. We do a lot of hiking, nature walks, running activities and field games that require sturdier play shoes. Make sure attire is also appropriate for outside play.
- Water Play Days these are done at parks that include splash pads, water features or when water toys are brought out (water balloons, spray toys etc)
 - Days that are designated Water Play Days will require your child is provided with the following
 - i. Swimsuit worn <u>underneath</u> clothes. Camp shirts will still be worn over bathing suits/during water play
 - ii. Spare clothes to change into when water play is finished
 - Closed toe water shoes barefoot or flip flops/backless shoes pose a health and safety risk.
 Backup shoes to change into afterwards is also an option
 - i. Beach towel
